A higher-level language course that requires one of these courses as a prerequisite may also be used to fulfill the requirement.
- Placement exams are required for several languages. Should a student place higher than the beginning level, any lower level requirements listed on the four year guide will need to be replaced with a free elective if needed for total hours for the degree.
