## Additional Notes:

- Should a student need to begin their Math sequencing with MAT 1025, they will need to contact the Department of Mathematic Sciences during their first semester for an academic planning session.
- The course sequence MAT 2110, MAT 3010, MAT 3015, MAT 4015, and CI 4900 must be taken in sequence as each course is a prerequisite for the next one in line. Additionally, MAT 3010 is a fall-only course; MAT 3015 is a spring-only course; MAT 4015 is a fall-only course.
- A contract with a list of the approved courses MUST be filed with the College of Arts \& Sciences Dean’s Office no later than the end of the first semester of junior year.
- Reading \& English proficiencies required.
- Admission to Teacher Education is required. To be admitted to the Teacher Education Program students must have a minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA and take \& satisfy testing requirements for Reading, Writing and Math areas of the PRAXIS (PPST or CBT).
- Graduation \& licensure requires a cumulative 2.7 GPA.
