- Foreign Language requirements:
- Students are required to demonstrate intermediate-level proficiency in a language other than English. Intermediate-level proficiency is demonstrated by successful completion of a $4^{\text {th }}$ semester language course (FL 1050 or 1060). A higher level language course that requires one of these courses as a prerequisite may also be used to fulfill the requirement.
- Placement exams are required for several languages. Should a student place higher than the beginning level, any lower level requirement listed on the four year guide will need to be replaced with a free elective if needed for total hours for the degree. Please consult with your advisor for more information.
- NOTE: Appalachian's language placement test is designed for placement purposes only, and a score on this test alone is not sufficient to demonstrate intermediate-level proficiency.
- Residency Requirements:
- 30 hours must be from ASU ( $25 \%$ of the credit hours required for the degree).
- 18 hours in the major must be from ASU.
- 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU.
