Residency Requirements:

- \circ 30 hours must be from ASU (25% of the credit hours required in the degree).
- 18 hours in the major must be from ASU.
- \circ $\,$ 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU (if required).
- BSC 4900 Internship (3 S.H) and BSC 4901 Internship Portfolio (3 S.H.) should be taken in the summer between the Junior and Senior year or later.
- A minor is not required but a minor in Community and Regional Planning or Sustainable Technology is recommended.
